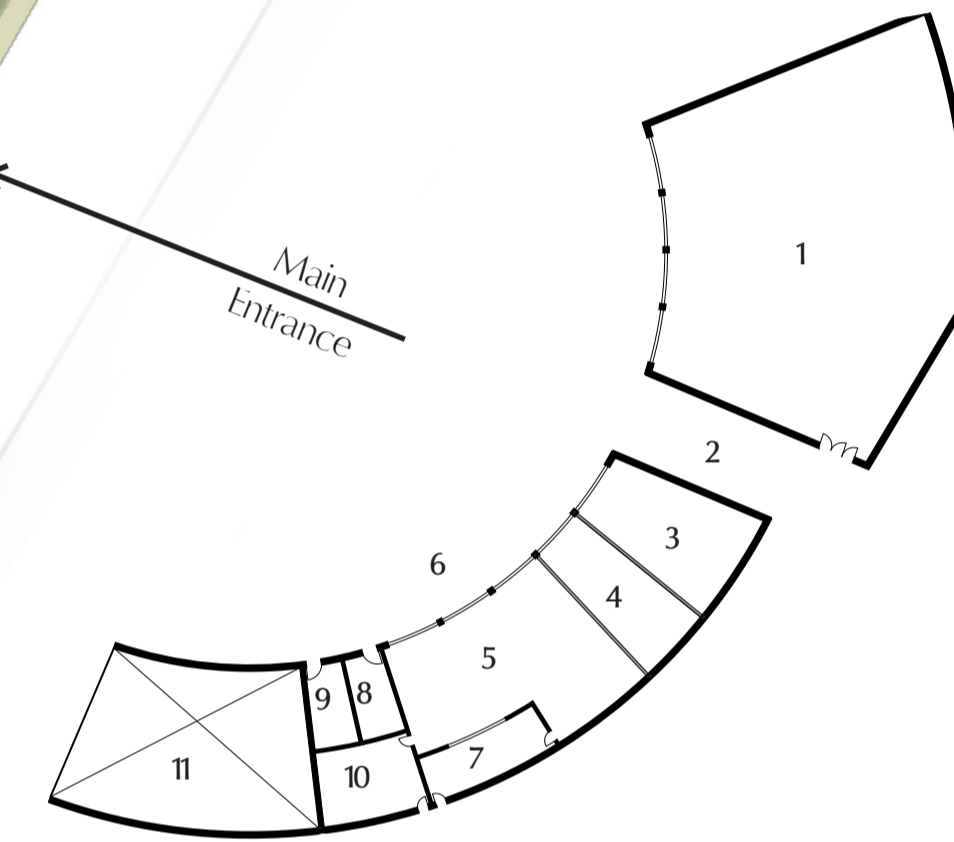
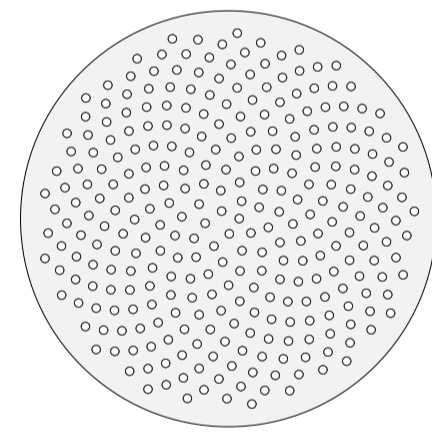
Memorial Procession



- 1 On the evening of July 17, those wishing to remember those on flight MH17 gather at the Visitor Centre where they watch the sun set down the avenue at 20:56.
- 2 Once the sun has disappeared below the mound, the group walk along the avenue to the mound top. From here, they can see the 298 discs illuminated below in the meadow.
- 3 Using the ramp within the mound, the group descends to ground level and walks within the meadow. Those wishing quiet contemplation at this stage can sit on the steps and look out over the water.
- 4 The group then makes its way back to the Visitor Centre via the ground level path.

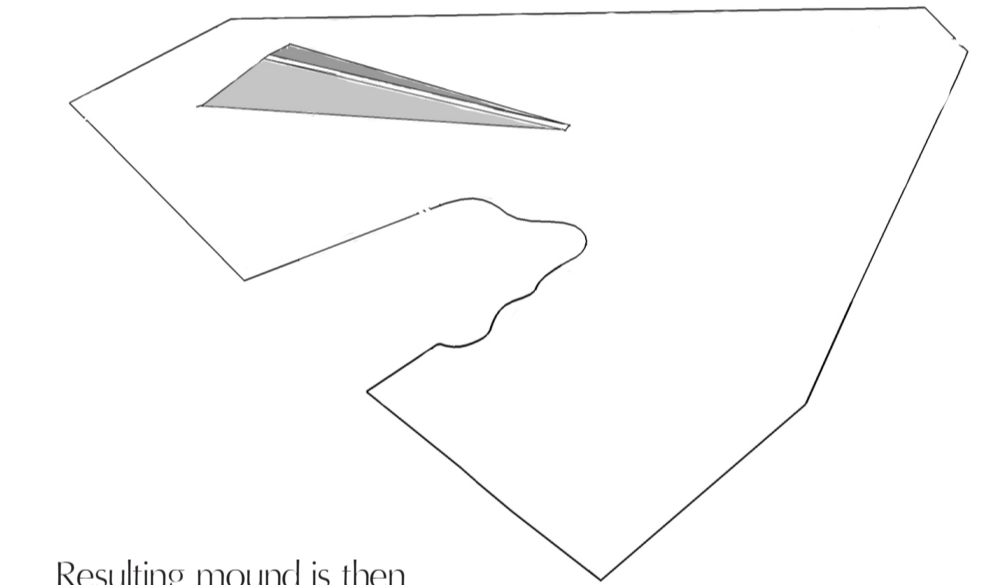
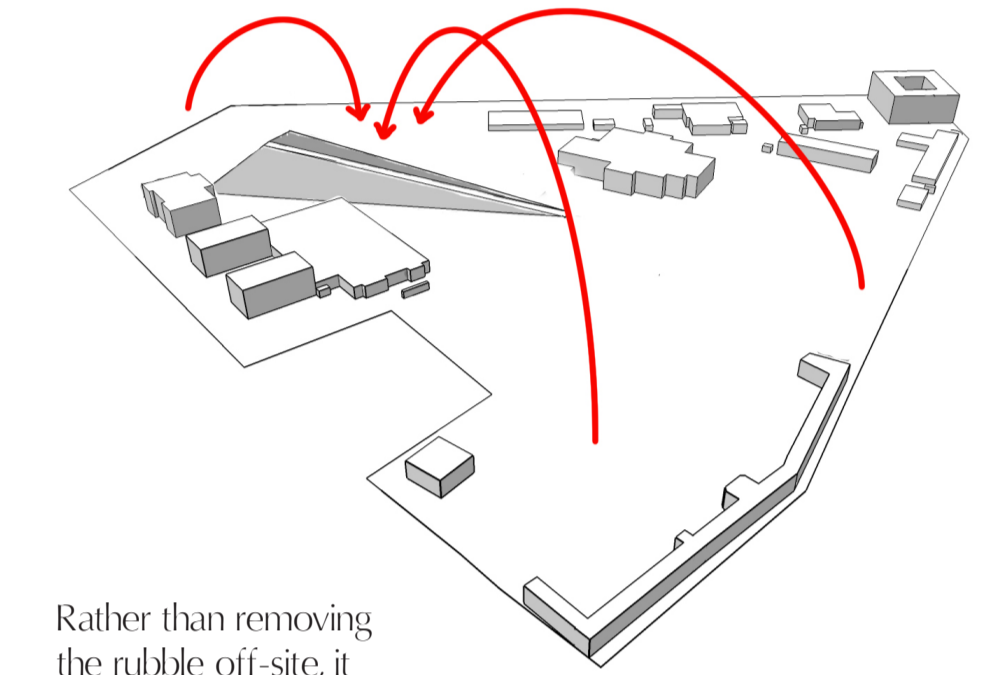
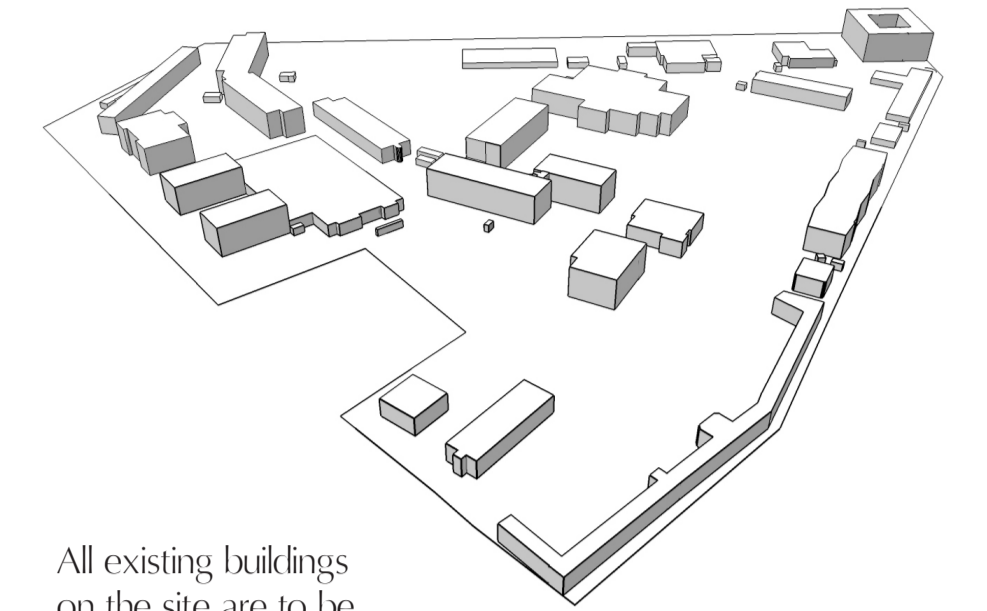
Memorial Meadow

The Memorial Meadow consists of a wildflower meadow in the centre of which 298 white discs, each measuring 80cm in diameter, have been embedded flush with the soil surface. Around them, a wildflower meadow is planted. At night, each of the discs is illuminated from below causing the meadow to glow, when viewed at ground level, or the individual discs to be visible in their spiralling pattern, when viewed from the mound above.
